Quantitative Versus Qualitative Research, or Both?

Quantitative research aligns with the positivist paradigm, whereas qualitative research most closely aligns itself with the naturalistic paradigm Quantitative research is a formal, objective, deductive approach to problem solving In contrast, qualitative research is a more informal, subjective, inductive approach to problem solving
