Designing SAP Application Security

The first key decision to make during the actual design of SAP security is whether to use “job-based” or “task-based” roles The intention of job-based roles is to give each user one role (eg, Accounts Payable Manager) that encompasses all of that person’s job activities This approach

1. Scope and application 2. Responsibilities

- Indicate in the “Responsibilities” section who is doing what Do not use people’s name, use functions / job title eg laboratory technician, physician...
- In clude all necessary information to perform the procedure, not more • Use the fewest possible words, if different steps ...

A well-defined object supports a clearly defined role some roles are application-specific such as an image import plug-in for Adobe Photoshop but some roles are generic; RDD refers to generic roles as “role stereotypes” or just “stereotypes” do not confuse this ...
