The salon may not open until it is approved by the Ohio State Board of Cosmetology Inspector *Remember to check local government agencies* [] A Beauty Salon Application is required It should be returned to the Ohio State Board of Cosmetology It will take about 30 days to process

Instructions and Requirements

If your salon does not comply with the required width or total square footage, you may request a variance To request a variance, you must: A Submit a written request for a variance explaining why you are requesting the variance; and B Submit a sketch on 8½" x 11" paper that shows the dimensions of your salon for every wall
