Relative clauses Two types of Relative clauses: Restrictive: closely connected with the antecedent This is not something that would disturb me Non-restrictive: Nouns which are already definite They add something to the noun by given more information about it They are not essential and can be omitted

RELATIVE CLAUSES - INGLÉS

There are two types of relative clauses: 1 Defining relative clauses 2 Non-defining relative clauses DEFINING RELATIVE CLAUSES These describe the preceding noun in such a way to distinguish it from other nouns of the same class A clause of this kind is essential to clear understanding of the noun The boy who was playing is my brother
