The Russian Revolution was also, and profoundly, a social revolution One reason Russia so needed good leadership was that both the economic and social systems were in transition and placing tremendous stresses on the population Shaken by defeat in the Crimean War of 1854-56, Alexander II launched Russia on a cautious path of reform

1905 Russia completed the Trans-Siberian Railroad in 1903, and obtained a 25 year lease of the Liaotung Peninsula, extended its sphere of influence into Manchuria, and began penetration of Korea This resulted in a conflict with Japan The Russo-Japanese War (1904-05) triggered the Revolution of 1905 Revolution of 1905
