kind of physical abuse, emotional abuse, sexual abuse or neglect (see point 42 below) All children without exception have the right to protection from abuse regardless of gender, ethnicity, disability, sexuality, or beliefs No child or group of children should be treated any less favourably than others

Somebody may abuse or neglect a child by inflicting harm, or by failing to act to prevent harm Children may be abused in a family, institution, online, educational or community setting Abuse may take the form of physical, emotional, sexual abuse and/or neglect 4 What is the purpose of Safeguarding/Child Protection? 4 Child protection is part of this definition and refers to activities undertaken to prevent children suffering, or being likely to suffer, significant harm Abuse is a form of maltreatment of a child and may involve inflicting harm or failing to act to prevent harm Neglect is a form of abuse and is the persistent failure to meet a child's basic physical and/or psychological

Child protection is a central part of but not separate to safeguarding It is the process of protecting individual It is the process of protecting individual children identified as either suffering or at risk of significant harm as a result of abuse or programme of work

The Safeguarding and Child Protection policy will be reviewed on an annually basis by the Governing Body or when any Government guideline changes for Safeguarding and Child Protection are announced The new changes will then implemented by the Designated Safeguarding Lead as part of their role and responsibilities Safeguarding and Child

All other staff have Safeguarding training updated as appropriate Any weaknesses in Child Protection are remedied immediately A trustee, usually the Chair, is nominated to liaise with the Local Authority (LA) on Child Protection issues and in the event of an allegation of abuse made against the Principal
